SUBJECT: National Grievance Committee

WHEREAS, there are times when members may encounter scheduling conflicts or an illness;
and

WHEREAS, the financially and prudent time to conduct a grievance committee hearing shall be in conjunction with a regularly scheduled National Executive Committee (NEC) meeting; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that two (2) alternates shall be appointed to the grievance committee, therefore be it further

RESOLVED, from among the membership of the National Executive Committee (NEC), the national commander shall appoint a National Grievance Committee, consisting of three (3) members and two (2) alternate members to hear grievances and appeals as are provided for in this constitution and by- laws and shall report its findings and recommendations to the proper authorities. The national commander shall designate the chairman of said committee.

The committee shall function during the National Convention and meetings of the National Executive Committee. Such appointees shall serve at the pleasure of the national commander. The national commander and the national judge advocate shall serve as ex-officio members of said committee without vote.
